Nomination for the Bronze Pelican Emblem

The Bronze Pelican Emblem

The Bronze Pelican Emblem is a diocesan recognition granted by the Diocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting with the approval of the Bishop. It may be presented to any adult working in or supporting Scouting programs (Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, American Heritage Girls and Camp Fire) under Catholic auspices or in units not partnered by the Church, and to those who have made a significant contribution to Scouting in the field of Catholic relationships. Recipients may be Catholic men and women, including priests and religious, and non-Catholic individuals.

The purpose of this emblem is to recognize an outstanding contribution to the spiritual development of Catholic youth in Scouting programs.

Nomination forms should give a detailed description of how the nominee provides outstanding contribution to the spiritual development of Catholic youths through Scouting in the Catholic Church. It is improper to nominate oneself or one's spouse. General scouting achievements do not qualify a person for the Bronze Pelican emblem. Each Scouting organization has district, council, regional and national awards for such recognition.

General Guidelines for nomination and selection: The following points provide examples of activities the Selection Committee is looking for. The list is not inclusive, as there are many other areas that could be considered.

- A minimum 3 years in scouting.
- Has fulfilled all diocesan guidelines for volunteers working with youth
- Promotes the religious emblems programs for Catholic youths and/or serves as a counselor, moderator or coordinator.
- Is an exemplary adult and member in good standing in his/her respective positions in Scouting and his/her faith community.
- Encourages non-Catholic youths to participate in the religious emblems programs appropriate to their faith tradition.
- Gives notable service in promoting Catholic activities and service projects for the church and is willing to serve on committees for those purposes.
- Active participation in and promotion of Scout retreats and days of recollection.
- Notable service in bringing the Catholic Scouting program to youths not in Catholic-chartered Scouting units.

- Is fully trained in the skills of scouting and is outstanding for his/her sense of responsibility, humility and good example.
- Consistently maintains and interprets to the Scouting community the Catholic attitude and identity towards Scouting and thus becomes responsible for having religious policies carried out to the benefit of the Catholic boys and girls.
 - * Leading others to deepen their knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith
 - *Modeling behavior that reflects Gospel values
 - *Teaching respect and dignity for all people
 - *Encouraging Scouts to live out the faith commitment made at Baptism
 - *Responsible for Catholic Scouts being transported to Mass at camp outs and other scout outings, and providing for the Spiritual needs of the non-Catholic scouts
- Leadership in the promotion of Scouting for all youths regardless of race or creed.
