

THE IAP JESSICA & NIFTE MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIP

The Jessica & Nifte Immigration Assistance Fellowship was established at the IAP to honor the memory of Jessica Lowery Castro and Nifte Granados. These young women were assisting migrant workers as outreach workers for Farmworker Legal Services (FLS) when they were involved in a fatal car crash in 1999. Both were pursuing college educations to enable them to fulfill their shared dream of providing legal assistance to migrant workers and other immigrants.

This fellowship fulfills their dreams by funding interns to support the professional staff of the IAP and FLS in assisting immigrants in obtaining lawful residence, work authorization, and US citizenship.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

The IAP and FLS have teamed up to raise funds for the Jessica & Nifte Fellowship through the sale of t-shirts. The shirts display the motto that Jessica and Nifte strived to achieve: "Todos Tienen Derechos" (Everybody Has Rights). The FLS logo appears on the back of the shirt.

Consultation Fees are due at the time of the consultation.

Service Fees are due at the time of finalizing the applications or petitions for submission to USCIS.

Applications will not be released to the client nor mailed to USCIS under any circumstances if the services fees have not been paid in full.

Service Fees can be paid by cash or money order.

FEE WAIVER POLICIES

A waiver of all or part of a service fee may be available to families whose fees to the IAP exceed \$1500 and the aggregate family income falls below 125% of the poverty line. This waiver is granted at the discretion of the Program Director.

A waiver of all or part of a service fee for the Battered Spouse Adjustment of Status packet may be available if the client's income falls below 100% of the poverty line or s/he is residing at a domestic violence shelter at the time of service.

There is no waiver of the consultation or yearly maintenance fee except when the prospective client is residing at a domestic violence shelter or other homeless shelter or is homeless at the time of the consultation.

HOW TO BE A CLIENT OF IAP

The Immigration Assistance Program accepts new clients only after an initial consultation. Initial consultations are held on Mondays and on designated Thursdays in Hartford, Michigan (please call the office to get the Thursday dates). The appointments are on a walk-in basis between the hours of 9am and 4pm (closed for lunch 12:30-1:30pm). If it is determined by the IAP that there is a manner in which we can help the prospective client, we will provide that person with a list of documents required for the submission of their application/petition and an appointment for follow-up.

It is important that when you attend your initial consultation, that you bring all correspondence that you received from US Citizenship & Immigration Services or the National Visa Center and copies of all documents that have been submitted to either of those agencies.

The adult for whom the immigration benefit is being sought should attend the initial consultation with the Petitioner (i.e. if you want to file for your spouse, both you and your spouse need to attend the consultation).

If you require emergency services or you are living in a domestic violence shelter, the initial consultation may be held on a day other than Monday with prior arrangement with this office. No walk-ins will be attended on days other than Mondays or designated Thursdays.

OFF-SITE CONSULTATIONS
