BLACK EVANGELIZATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

The Office of Schools in collaboration with the National Office of Black and Native American Missions is pleased to offer the Black Evangelization Scholarship Program established to:

1. Assist families in making Catholic Education more affordable;
2. Assist in sustaining and increasing enrollment through an on-going scholarship program.

The scholarship process consists of the following:

1. The school advertises the scholarship program through newsletters, parish bulletins, and other media. The school must verify publication of the availability of the scholarship fund;
2. Families inquiring about the Black Evangelization Scholarship Program are asked to submit to the school administrator an application with the requested supporting financial disclosures;
3. All applications are to be completed by May 15th;
4. The Diocesan Coordinator of the Scholarship Program will determine the level of assistance to be given based upon family need and the annual allocation to the Diocese of Kalamazoo;
5. Funds will be released to the schools in January; and
6. The whole community is encouraged to support the efforts of the National Office of Black and Native American Missions by way of the annual Diocesan KDSA drive.

Administrator Instructions re: Black Evangelization Scholarship Fund

1. Allocations are based upon need and awards are made by the Diocesan Coordinator of the Scholarship Program.
2. Announce via parish bulletin/s, newsletters and any other manner that applications are now being accepted for the Black Evangelization Scholarship Fund.
3. Clarify that this is a need-based scholarship program.
4. Announcements need to appear for several weeks in April and early May.
5. Applications are due in your office no later than May 15.
6. Administrators must complete the portion of the application which indicates their support of the applicant's request.
7. All completed applications must be forwarded to the Office of Schools postmarked no later than May 30 of the academic year.
8. Each school's allocation will be distributed in January. Funds are to be applied to the outstanding current year tuition of the recipient/s.
